

Minnesota Ballpark Authority Board Meeting Construction and Planning Update - September 21, 2007

### Construction:

- BNSF track, ties, and ballast in place through the Ballpark work-zone -
- Pile-driving continues on ballpark structure, just begun for plaza and pedestrian bridge over I-394 170 stadium piles placed in August
- Soil removal continues from the site-
- 5<sup>th</sup> Street bridgework ongoing between Northstar and Ballpark Project -

### Budget (see attached summary):

- IGMP established budget will be superseded by PGMP budget and scope in October -
- New contract Notice of Awards given to the following firms: Ambassador Steel, Woody's Rebar, Cemstone, Metropolitan Mechanical, New Mech, and Gephardt Electric final dollar amounts and community participation levels will be presented in conjunction with PGMP budget -
- Proposals received for stone façade -

### Design:

- Phased GMP Design Approval and Implementation Committee recommendations scheduled for October -
- Approval given to tie ballpark storm systems into Bassett Creek tunnel –
- Authorization by MBA to incorporate stairway connection from 6<sup>th</sup> Street pedestrian bridge to skyway -

### Schedule:

- BNSF track switchover in October is on schedule -
- Ability to reopen north lanes of 5<sup>th</sup> Street North bridge is hampered by the Met Council sewer project – City has been notified that reopening in this year is in jeopardy -
- Transfer girder construction over Bassett Creek is currently <u>the</u> project critical path progress is significantly hampered by poor soil conditions a six day workweek has been implemented to maintain schedule -

### Safety:

- No recordable or lost time incidents in August -
- Fourteen "near misses" reported to date typically in the form of unauthorized access to the site by pedestrians or bikers number of incidents have decreased with reopening of Cedar Lake bike trail -

### Community Participation:

- S/W/MBE project participation goals of 30%. Aggregate S/W/MBE participation to date of 29%, which represents \$7.9 million of \$29 million awarded -
- Workforce diversity participation goals of 25% minority and 5% female, expressed as percentage of total project work hours. Current participation to date of 13% minorities and 11% females with 5600 recorded hours worked -

### Quality:

• AET and Braun-Intertec providing on-site special inspections and testing. No NCRs (Non-Conformance Reports) generated in August

### Claims/Change Orders/Disputes:

- Various small changes acknowledged for unknown site conditions.
- Claim received by Rehbein for additional compensation regarding soils removal and disposal has been denied – will be forwarded to next level of Dispute Resolution process -
- Approval of Bassett Creek storm drain connections will result in redesign and re-pricing of scope -
- Ballpark project has "fixed" electrical vault settlement at Ford Centre that is the result of Met Council sewer relining project, in order to maintain schedule -




















