

Minnesota Ballpark Authority Meeting Minutes - May 13, 2011

Chair Steve Cramer called the special meeting of the Minnesota Ballpark Authority for May 13, 2011 to order at 1:00 p.m. The roll was taken. Commissioners Barb Sykora, Martin Olav Sabo, Joan Campbell and Paul D. Williams were present. Kathleen Lamb, Legal Counsel, was also present.

Commissioner Sykora moved approval of the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Campbell and approved unanimously – 5 YEAS, O NAYS.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

• Executive Director Kenney stated that he and Chair Cramer signed the easement agreements with BSNF. The MBA continues to work with the Interchange Project on the design process. Mr. Kenney also informed the board that the Ford Center is over 90% pre-leased, which is a good sign for development in the area.

Purpose:

Background:

The MBA Chair is appointed by the Hennepin County Board pursuant to the ballpark legislation. Purpose:

To elect an Audit Committee Chair and members.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Target Field Operations – Matt Hoy, Vice President, Twins Ballpark Operations

Mr. Hoy stated that the batter's eye screen has been rebuilt. Wi-Fi for the ballpark has been updated and activated. After the 10 month warranty review there are 31 issues that remain. Cracks in the concrete and some areas where it is slippery when wet need to be addressed. Cracks in the parking lot and dock area will be fixed soon. There have been a few challenges with the wood backed seats on club level. Some have been replaced due to damage by hit balls or fans climbing on them.

Severe weather concerns: Mr. Hoy stated that Target Field is certified as a storm ready facility, and that they employ a meteorologist during game days, so Target Field is well aware of any severe or threatening weather. The Twins have a full disaster response and emergency plan in place.

B. Hennepin County Interchange Project – George Fantauzza, Project Designer

Mr. Fantauzza gave a Power-Point presentation on the Interchange Project. They are approximately half way through the environmental assessment. The project started getting

development ideas in February of 2010, and there should be a draft by mid-summer and a final design by Fall of 2011.

D. MBA Financial Report – Brenda Juneau, MBA Finance Coordinator

Ms Juneau gave a brief overview of the MBA financials. A 2010 Financial Report review was included in packet materials, and a Comprehensive Report Summary for 2010 should be complete in about a month.
